RE: Updated invoicing for Regulatory Intelligence following 2024 acquisition of Thomson Reuters Regulatory Intelligence assets by CUBE

This letter serves as a courtesy update to how you will be invoiced for your continued access to Regulatory Intelligence. In summary, any fees due under your agreement for Regulatory Intelligence services will now be invoiced by CUBE rather than Thomson Reuters. There are no changes to your agreement for such services.

Following a period of transition, CUBE will now be responsible for invoicing for such services as the sole supplier.
